The reception will feature key scholars, award-winning Houston-based visual artists, and a culinary experience that highlights African Americans Military contributions and explores the nuances of liberation in America.

A family-friendly festival on the lawn behind BSNM featuring a living history encampment of the United States Colored Troops, arts and crafts, demonstrations, family activities, and a marketplace with Black and Veteran-owned businesses and community organizations. Educational festivities inside the museum include interactive stations with a reflection space, a community oral history project, genealogy, opportunities for healing and wellness, performances, and a youth history activation.
